Business:

- <u>New Board Member:</u> We are still in need of a new board member. Amy had talked to a few people about it, but the 6-year term was the major deterrent on not wanting to join. The board discussed on whether we are able to shorten the term limit from 6 years to 3 years. Amy will talk to Bonnie and find out what they State Library has to say on the matter. Sandy said that she would ask Ruth Agle and Julie Lancaster. If neither of them was interested, Amy will talk to Tori Leeper and Pam Herrold. Amy said that she had completely forgotten to look into it last month and would look into that again and report back next month on the cost. Next month we will discuss whether or not we should renew/reinstate our movie license.
